Cultivation Practices

- I. Origin- Indian origin plant (NE Region)
- 2. Oil used in oriental perfumes
- 3. Planting Time- May September by
- 4. Planted by-Vegetative Propagation/ Direct Fresh Rhizome Planting or through nursery plants
- 5. Spacing- 45x45 cm
- 6. No of Planting Material- 18000-20000 plants/ Acre
- 7. Crop Duration- 2 Years
- 8. Planted one time only
- 9. Yield-

Fresh Rhizome- 5-6 t/acre

Dry yield- **1.5 – 2.0 t/acre**

Oil yield- 0.7- 1.0 %

Note- Only 70% Harvest is Possible
